

Cats


Cats live all over the world. Even though the cat is now a domestic animal, it was first a wild animal. Because people have brought them to the city, it is known as a domestic animal.

My favourite hobby is reading books. There are many books in my bookshelf. I chose reading books because it is a knowledge-


able, interesting and enjoyable hobby.
