**Post Title: Consultant (SSA Contract)**

Under the overall supervision of the UNFPA Representative, and his/her designated officer, the Consultant will conduct a situational analysis on ASRH issues in Sri Lanka in close collaboration with the Director Youth, Elderly and Disabled of the Ministry of Health.

#### **Expected Output:**

The consultant is expected to produce a comprehensive situational analysis report that includes a literature review and the analysis of data gaps with recommendations for intervention. The report should include the situational analysis with a list of available research and studies on ASRH which summarises and assesses their usefulness for programming. An identification of knowledge gaps in ASRH knowledge a list of available data on ASRH indicators in the country with recommendations based on the findings of the review.

#### Methodology:

The country situation analysis will use the following methodologies:

- Desk review of literature including published and unpublished studies, document, reports and Information. Education and Communication (IEC) materials. Literature search and data collection can include internet search using websites of international and local organizations covering various aspects of ARH: and library search in UNFPA and other international agencies, academic institutions such as the Universities of Kelaniya and Sri Jayawardenepura government agencies. NGOs who have ARH papers, studies, reports, materials.
- Interviews with key stakeholders to validate, update and enrich information gathered from the literature research.
- The consultant may engage the services of a research assistant if needed
