- A minimum of 3 years experience.

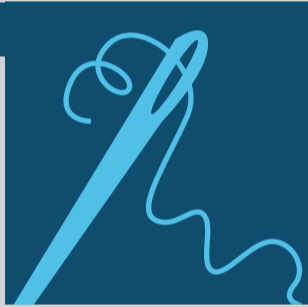


INDUSTRIAL ENGINEER

- Experience in the use of ERP systems will be an added advantage.

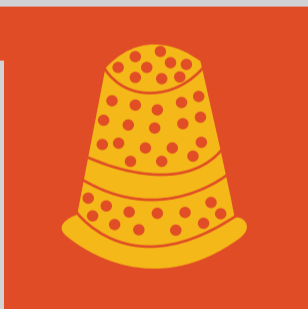


PRODUCTION PLANNING COORDINATOR

- A Degree or Diploma in Textile Technology.

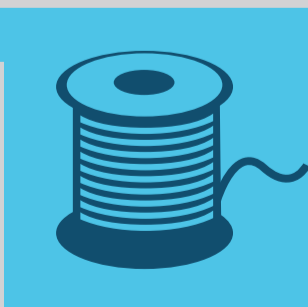


QUALITY AUDIT IN-CHARGE

- A Degree or a Diploma in Clothing Technology.

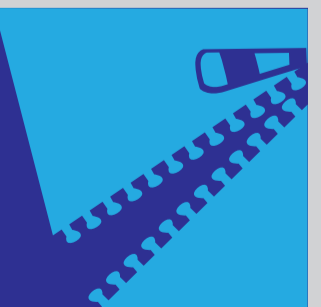


MECHANIC
